Vocational Futures Planning and Support (VFPS) is a comprehensive, team-based, participant-directed employment strategy for individuals with physical disabilities.

The process is based on the premise that individuals with disabilities do not lack the aptitude or motivation to pursue their employment goals. Rather, it's the presence of multiple barriers and the lack of opportunity that prevents people with significant disabilities from going to work.

Using the VFPS process, an individual is empowered to be an active participant in guiding and shaping career choices and decisions. These materials were created to help individuals participating in and professionals who are a part of the Vocational Futures Planning and Support (VFPS) process.
