The app is a fun and interactive tool that mirrors the Postsecondary Transition Plan (PTP) in the Individualized Education Program (IEP) and provides a student and family voice to transition planning.



The app prioritizes the student's preferences, interests, strengths, and needs in future planning while promoting the development of self-advocacy and self-determination skills.



Upon completion, a report will be generated that can be used by the student during their IEP Team meeting. Additionally, the report can be utilized by the IEP Team to facilitate the creation of the PTP.



Recognize and appreciate the diverse resources that a student, family, and community bring to the table when creating a student's transition plan. Take into account the valuable strengths and assets provided by the individual, family, and community backgrounds.

It is recommended that the student sends an email of the report to themselves, their family, and their teacher prior to their IEP Team meeting. Additionally, they should download the final version of the report.



When a student is unable to express themselves in a traditional way, it is important to include the student's voice through the app. In such instances, it is recommended to engage a family member or educator to fill out the app on behalf of the student.

Family members are encouraged to engage with the app alongside the student before the student's IEP meeting. This approach will effectively prepare them to fully participate in a discussion regarding transition planning during the IEP meeting.



Support and explore strategies that allow the student to communicate their strengths and needs during their student-led IEP Team meeting to reach their transition goals. These methods may include creating an agenda, PowerPoint presentation, picture cards, or a scripted presentation aligned with their app report.
